Showmanship by grade levels with Belt Buckles to Winners

Sponsorship is also available with the online entry portal, the support of our families, and businesses make our show a success and allow us to give back 100% to the exhibitors !!

1. Any exhibitor 21 years of age or under is eligible to show. *Open to Georgia Pre-Club, 4-H and FFA Exhibitors*
2. All swine must be blood tested PRV and Brucellosis negative within 30 days of the show and have an official health certificate. All out-of-state swine must have a prior permit number on the health certificate.
3. Market barrows and market gilts will be shown separately by weight. Purebred gilts with registration certificates will be shown by breed and by age. Purebred barrows will be shown by weight and go back to compete with market barrows for overall barrow. If enough for a breed class of purebred barrows we can add, must have 7 to hold a breed class. **Breeds recognized if enough**, Berkshires, Duroc, Hampshires, Landrace, Yorkshire and all others will be A.O.B
4. The barn will open at 3:00 p.m. on December 9th , 2022. All market hogs and purebred barrows must be weighed and registered gilts must be checked in by 7:00 p.m. that same day. **THIS IS NOT A WEIGH BACK SHOW !!!**

5. There is no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor.

6. Prize money will be paid to the top 10 in each class. Contingent on number of entries and sponsors if funds permit.

7. All entries must be submitted online by December 1st, 2022. The entry fee is \$35.00 per pig. A late fee of \$20.00 per head will be required after this date. The committee reserves the right to refund money to entries if the number of entries exceeds pen space. All entries can be processed online. If you do not have access to the online option for entry please reach out to Missy Tolbert (706)340-7166 or Teri Tankersley (706)340-6703. Entry fees cannot be switched from one exhibitor to another. The late fee will be strictly enforced. No refunds on entry fees.

8. Market Hog Show: Barrows and gilts will show separately. Divisions in the barrow and gilt market hog shows will be divided evenly among the classes, as far as possible. All purebred barrows must be registered with a proper registration certificate from the National Swine Registry. There must be 7 entries to hold a breed class. If there is not, the purebred barrow will be placed in Other Breeds. If there are not enough entries for a purebred division, they will show as crossbred market barrows. Division winners will compete for Grand Champion honors. The judge will select Grand and Reserve Champions for the barrow show and the gilt show. All market hog entries must have a clean, readable ear tag in place. Pigs must be tagged before check in.

9. Registered Breeding Gilt Show: All gilts must be registered with a proper registration certificate from the National Swine Registry for their respective breed. Purebred entries must show the exhibitor's name or exhibitor's family farm as the current owner on the registration paper. Registered breeding gilts do not have to have ear tags but must be ear notched according to their registration certificate. Entries must be farrowed in June, July, August, or September 2022. A minimum of 7 head will be required to hold a breed show. If there are less than 7 head of a breed, they will be shown as All Other Breeds. Breed Champions and Reserve Champions will be chosen for each breed. A Supreme Overall Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion Breeding Gilt will be chosen. Breeds recognized if enough, Berkshires, Duroc, Hampshires, Landrace, Yorkshire and all others will be A.O.B

10. The pen fee is \$10.00 per pen. If you have special penning request please email Teri Tankersley at ttankersley@madison.k12.ga.us

11. Showing from the trailer will be permitted. A fee of \$40.00 will be charged. They are outside with no cover overhead. Limited number of spaces. Tents are permitted over the rear of your trailer for shade or rain, but all personal items like coolers, chairs, tables need to be set up in the tongue area of your space. Please do not have items behind your trailer, pigs can't pass through to get to the show ring.

12. Showmanship: Showmanship will begin at 9:00am on Saturday December 10th, 2022. Exhibitors must pay a \$15.00 entry fee for showmanship. Classes will be broken down by the exhibitors' grade level. Showmanship will be shown from the youngest to oldest and broken into heats according to the number of entries. 1st Grade and Under, 2nd/3rd, 4th/5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th for a total of 10 classes. There will not be collegiate showmanship. Belt Buckles to Champion for each class and cash payouts through top 10.

13. We will offer additional premiums to Georgia Bred pigs that have an Official Georgia Bred tag in the ear.

The rules committee reserves the right to interpret all rules. Decision of the judge and the rules committee will be final.

No alcoholic beverages permitted on show grounds! Smoking, dipping, chewing, or spitting allowed there is a designated smoking area located outside the facility.

Children must be supervised at all times. There is no "horse play" type of behavior permitted in the facility.
